

Marble Maze Activity Form

<i>9th Walton</i>		<i>Brief Description of Activity: Players hold and tilt a 4ft x 2ft wooden tray to roll a marble through the maze of passages to reach the other side.</i>
		<i>No of Participants at any one Time: 2 - 6</i>
		<i>Space Required: 3m x 2m</i>
<i>Risk Assessment</i>		
List any Hazards in order of Significance	Groups of People who may be Harmed	Control Measures and back-up Arrangements to Minimise Hazard
<i>Dropping the tray</i>	<i>Participants</i>	<i>Ensure there are enough participants to hold the tray safely.</i>
<i>Possible choking due to swallowing the marble.</i>	<i>Participants</i>	<i>The marble is a very large one and so the risk is negligible. Ensure that the participants know that the marble is only to be used on the maze and should not be placed anywhere else.</i>
<i>Risk of splinters</i>	<i>Participants</i>	<i>Check that the wooden surfaces are smooth and splinter free. Rub down with sandpaper if required.</i>
